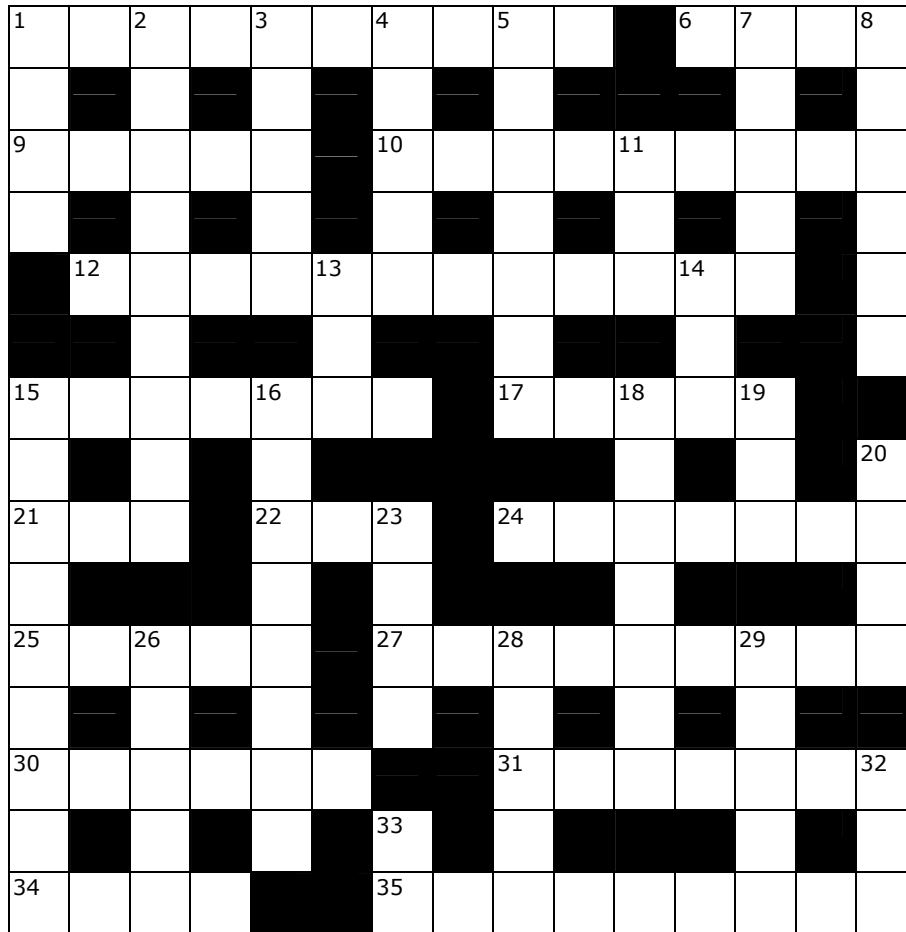


Easter Crossword - Running
